The sky is **too cloudy**

to observe very distant stars.

This telescope is not **powerful enough**

for me to buy.

The archeologists thought it was **too risky**

to watch the stars tonight.

This jade necklace is **too expensive**

to eat meat very often.

I am not **rich enough**

to open the tomb.

The peasants were **too poor**

to buy this jade necklace.

**Note:** With nouns, the word order is the same as in Czech: enough money, enough water, enough time...
