1) **SB 13 – Present Perfect Simple and Present Perfect Continuous** (*Předpřítomný čas prostý vs. průběhový*)
We are going to watch the grammar video and do some further practice in **OD5 online resources**.

Předpřítomný prostý čas používáme, pokud děj už někde proběhl, např. už mám přečtenou knihu.

I have read a book about extinct animals. - Četl/-a jsem knihu o vyhynulých zvířatech.

Nebo: I have read it twice. / I have read only 2 chapters. Četl jsem ji dvakrát. / Přečetl jsem jen 2 kapitoly.

- tady všude mluvím o tom, zda jsem něco udělal, kolikrát jsem to udělal, kolik jsem toho udělal...

Předpřítomný průběhový čas používáme, pokud se soustředíme na děj, ne na výsledek:

I've been reading the book about extinct animals since last week – Čtu tu knihu o vyhynulých zvířatech od minulého týdne. (Nezajímá mne teď, kolik jsem toho přečetl, dočetl...)

Compare these examples:

My hands are covered in paint because I've been painting a picture of a quagga. /Maluju.../

This picture looks beautiful – I've just painted it. /Namaloval jsem /

The kitchen smells nice because we've been baking a sea wolf pie – it's still in the oven. /Pečeme.../

We've baked a sea wolf pie – let's eat it! /Upekli jsme.../

My elephant bird has been eating too much recently – it's getting too fat./Poslední dobou jí.../

My elephant bird has eaten my popcorn! / Snědl.../

Girl Which animals have you been helping to protect over the years?

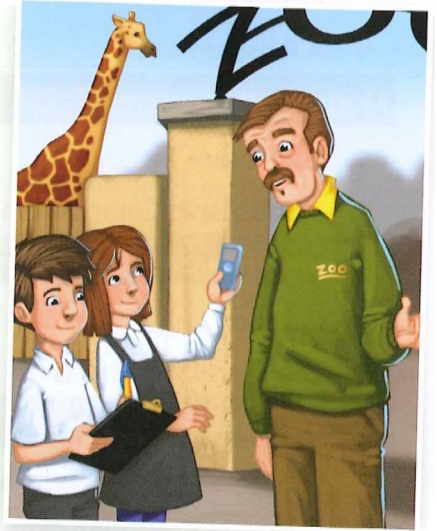
Zookeeper We've been helping to protect lots of endangered species.
